Seven students will each be awarded a U.S. Savings Bond for \$250.00. Deadline for submissions is December 1, 2006.

GUIDELINES: Each submission must contain an original, analytical or interpretive photographic image that has not been formally published elsewhere. Photographs should be a minimum size of 5" x 7"; film transparencies must be in 35mm format (no glass); digital images must be no less than 300 dpi. If submitting by mail, digital entries should be sent on a CD-Rom. *Group and/or joint-projects cannot be accepted. One entry per person.* All entries will be judged anonymously and will become property of the Studio for Southern California History and will be included in the Studio for Southern California History's programming and digital archive. Winning submissions will be highlighted at the Studio's bi-annual Story Symposium, a conference and forum highlighting our current programming.
